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Message from the Board

It took it's time but spring is finally here. That means the pool will soon be open! The pool will open on Memorial Day weekend and will be open every weekend until June 8th. Starting June 8th, the pool will be open daily.

To be a Lifeguard you must be Lifeguard/First-Aid/CPR/AED Certified. Lifeguard certification courses are taught by American Red Cross certified instructors. Participants learn to respond to water and land emergencies, to provide first aid care, and the responsibilities of a professional lifeguard. Participants also learn to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies for adults, children and infants in addition to learning how to properly use an AED on a victim of cardiac arrest.
