

## 2025 Hedgerow Homeowners Association (HHA) - Pool Rules

**Pool season is here!** Our neighborhood has an invaluable resource - we have our own community pool! Please read below for pool information and pool rules.

### Hours of Operation

- Hours: 12:00 PM Noon to 7:30 PM
- Closed for Lifeguard Dinner Break from 4:30 PM to 5:00 PM

### Summer 2025 Schedule

- Weekends Only – May 31/June 1, June 7/8, June 14/15
- Thereafter open 7 days per week from June 21 through August 24
- Final Weekend – Labor Day Weekend – Aug 30, Aug 31, Sep 1 (Labor Day)

While the daily pool operations and lifeguard staffing needs are managed by Fox Pool Management, responsibility for a successful pool season is also dependent upon cooperation of our volunteer HHA Board members and our residents. The pool rules below provide guidelines to ensure a successful and fun pool season.

## HHA Pool Rules - Apply to Residents and Guests

**To ensure a safe and enjoyable pool environment:**

**Alcohol, Smoking, and Vaping are strictly prohibited within the fenced pool area.**

### Access to Pool

- Residents will have access to the pool only during pool hours and under supervision of a qualified lifeguard. Residents may not enter the pool if a lifeguard is not present.
- Residents must show HHA pool tag to lifeguard and sign-in on the sheet located by the lifeguard. Residents without a valid tag must leave the area immediately. Failure to leave may result in a trespass warning and contact with local authorities.
- The pool may be closed at any time due to weather, operational difficulties, unavailability of a lifeguard, or at the discretion of any board member or lifeguard. All residents and guests must vacate the pool area when it is closed.

### Pool Tags

- Tags will be provided for all residents whose dues are current.
- Residents with unpaid dues may not use the pool, even as a guest of another resident.
- Pool access will be suspended for any resident whose HOA dues become delinquent after Memorial Day weekend, until the account is brought current.

### Pool Area Rules

- Alcohol, Smoking, and Vaping are strictly prohibited within the fenced pool area.

- Snacks and beverages are allowed only at the picnic tables and grassy area surrounding the pool. Each individual is responsible for cleaning up after themselves. Trash must be placed in the available containers.
- The water hose is not to be used for play.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear a pool-safe disposable diaper.
- Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
- Any person with a skin or communicable disease is excluded from using the pool.

### Behavior

- The lifeguard has the authority to remove anyone from the pool for misbehaving.
- Running, pushing, roughhousing, or excessive horseplay in pool area is not permitted.
- Ball playing may be permitted at the discretion of the lifeguard or Board members.
- Water wings or floatation vests are allowed in the adult pool area. All other balls, toys, rafts and tubes are at the lifeguard's discretion.

### Off-Hours Use

- Off-hours use of the pool is strictly prohibited and may result in suspension of privileges and involvement of law enforcement, depending on circumstances.

### Pump Room

- Only lifeguards, Board members, or the pool manager may enter the pump room. Unauthorized access may result in suspension of pool privileges.

### Authority

- Appeals or complaints about lifeguard decisions may be submitted to the Board for review.

### Children and Guests

- All children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Parents are responsible for the supervision and safety of their children in the baby pool.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Hedgerow resident aged 13 or older.
- Children aged 11 to 13 must pass the **Swimming Skills Test** to use the pool without adult supervision. Children may reattempt the test on another day if they fail initially.
- **Test includes:**
  1. Swimming 2 continuous laps between the 2 furthest points without dog paddling.
  2. Floating on their back unaided for 1 minute.
  3. Treading water unaided for 3 minutes.
- Children who pass the test will be issued a wrist band, and their name recorded.
- **Testing will begin Saturday June 21.** If the pool area is busy, the lifeguard may defer the opportunity for pool tests until sufficient attention may be given to the test.
- **Enjoy your swim, and thank you for cooperating with our community rules!**
